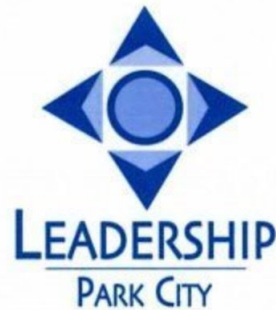

What's Up With Sue Kapis (9)

Sue Kapis (9) moved to Park City in 1997 after nearly 20 years of living in Fresno, CA.

Working in the agriculture industry, Sue met folks involved in investment/farming who owned a Deer Valley condo and generously invited her to make use of it on a cross-country trip the summer of 1992. *"I fell in love with Park City and started getting the Park Record. On a subsequent ski trip, Thanksgiving 1996, I networked and eventually landed a job with Claim Jumper as their in-house accountant. Fortunately, I had friends from Ski Patrol in California, who suggested that I rent their Park (Avenue condo in order to make a quick move, which was a blessing."*

Sue worked for the Claim Jumper for 3 years before going to work for the Chamber/Bureau in

2000. ***"My favorite part of my job has been the ability to have met so many great people in the business community."***



Experiences Galore

One of the highlights of Sue's tenure with the Chamber was her involvement with the 2002 Olympics. ***"I had gotten involved with Bobsled/Skeleton in late 1997 and eventually earned a spot on the start team for the Olympics."***

Professionally and personally, Sue is a living, breathing advocate for Park City. ***"As the saying goes 'We came for the winters but stayed for the summers'. I love the 4 seasons that I never really got to experience in California. I love being able to share my Park City experiences with our guests, whether it is in an official capacity or taking part in activities on my own."*** Although the bulk of her job duties at the Chamber/Bureau are administrative, she also acts as the Film Commissioner and sells the Park City area to those who are interested in shooting here whether it is for commercials, TV or movies. She also volunteered as a Saturday Mountain Host at PCMR for 7 years and loved talking to the guests and giving them ideas of places to eat or other things to do.

Upon arrival to Park City, Sue joined Park City Ambassadors and her leisure time was spent volunteering for various organizations which gave her a great overview of the community. Currently her favorite summer activity is playing golf but her winter activity is being involved with the sports of Bobsled/Skeleton.

Since the Olympics she worked her way up from being a volunteer official at Utah Olympic Park to taking her international jury license exam in 2008. ***"I coordinate local officials for the races at Utah Olympic Park (World Cup, North American Cup, Intercontinental Cup, Para Bobsled/Skeleton) and sit on juries in North America as the President of the Jury or as a Jury member. I assisted in training Bobsled/Skeleton volunteers for the 2010 Vancouver Olympics and was on their Start team. It was so exciting to see Steve Holcomb's team take gold in 4-man bobsled. Most recently, I was part of the Finish team for Bobsled/Skeleton at the PyeongChang 2018 Winter Olympics after working with many of their volunteer officials when they came to Park City for races or were part of the North American juries leading up to the Olympics."***

Leadership Connections

A participant in the Leadership Park City program back when it was still in single digits....Sue was excited to be a member of class 9. "It was such an honor to be selected for Class IX on my first application to the program. I met so many people through the program I probably would have never met otherwise. It was my classmate, Linda Jager (9), who got me onto the Park City Film Series board. It is so exciting to see my classmates becoming so involved in the community, especially those who jumped into the political scene or school board. I highly recommend the program to others who are interested in becoming a more active member of the community. Congratulations to Leadership Park City on your 25th Anniversary."

As far as bucket list items, in addition to playing more golf, most of Sue's 'hope to' items

include travel....especially traveling for Bobsled/Skeleton events and heading to Beijing in 2022 for the inaugural Paralympics for Bobsled.
